## START

No (ISC)<sup>2</sup> Chapter Near You? Start One!

The basic requirements to start an (ISC)<sup>2</sup> Chapter:

- (ISC)<sup>2</sup> credential holders in good standing for at least three years.
- Petitioner must reside in the location of interest for at least one year.
- A minimum of 15 (ISC)<sup>2</sup> members are required to sign the application.
- Must have professional leadership experience.
- Not currently serving as an officer of another security chapter organization.
- No previous convictions of criminal activity or conduct.
